5	<p>The Cloud Factory Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough, New Zealand</p> <p>Perfumed with nettle ripe tropical fruits which are also evident on the palate along with limey flavours and a rich minerality - classic Marlborough Sauvignon. The wine is sappy fresh, clean and delicious. (V)</p>			£36
6	<p>Montresor Soave Classico 'Gran Guardia' - Veneto, Italy</p> <p>An excellent example of good quality Soave Classico, fresh and lightly fruity with delicate floral aromas of honeysuckle, elderflower and a hint of spice. Crisp and refreshing on the palate with good depth of honeyed fruit, and a clean, lightly nutty finish.(V)</p>			£38
7	<p>Genio Y Figura Albariño - Rias Baixas, Spain</p> <p>This unconventional and modern-style Albariño brings us closer to younger audience by being faithful to our roots since youth is not obstacle of quality. A bouquet of intense fresh white fruit with hints of citric fruit coming through. The palate is luscious and fresh. It would go perfectly with shellfish and fish. (V)</p>			£48
8	<p>Xanadu Estate Chardonnay - Margaret River, Western Australia</p> <p>This wine was named after the vineyards founder Dr John Lagan who emigrated to Australia from Omagh, Northern Ireland in 1968. The bouquet of this elegant, yet powerful Chardonnay offers both detailed purity and complexity. The palate is medium bodied and tightly coiled, displaying white peach, pear drop and grapefruit phenolics. The fine boned structure is augmented by a lovely creamy mouthfeel derived from lees stirring. Refined yet complex, the intense fruit and core of acidity combine to focus the wine perfectly to a lingering finish. (V)</p>			£54
9	<p>Domaine de la Motte Chablis - Burgundy, France</p> <p>The flavour profile of this sits somewhere in between the Chablis and Petit Chablis from Domaine de la Motte. It has a restrained savoury, citrus and herbal nose followed by greater intensity on the palate. Cooked lemons, green apples and a stoney minerality are complemented by a nice citrus acidity to the end with a lovely clean finish.</p>			£55
10	<p>Domaine Roblin Sancerre Terres Blanches - Loire, France</p> <p>Produced from the family's 19 hectares of vines growing in 'terres blanches' - chalky clay - soil. Vineyards are worked sustainably, organically where possible. It was cool-fermented in stainless steel and aged upon its lees for 5 months. Vibrant aromas of green apple and citrus. The palate is complex with ripe citrus and pear fruit, pithy grapefruit notes and an appealing stony edge to the long finish. The grapes were picked early to maintain their freshness. (V)</p>			£66
11	<p>Domaine Beranger Pouilly-Fuisse - Burgundy, France</p> <p>Featuring aromas of white-flesh fruits, toasted bread, honey, and hints of vanilla. With a round, rich and unctuous mouthfeel, the wine is balanced by a nice acidity, and a fresh, persistent finish with the flavour of hazelnut.</p>			£76
12	<p>Domaine Henri Villamont Puligny-Montrachet - Burgundy, France</p> <p>On the nose, it is fresh, elegant, complex and develops fruity notes of fresh hazelnut, white peach, gooseberry and floral notes such as narcissus and hyacinth. On the palate, a rich and fat wine, with a nutty and delicious flavour: the balance between unctuous and freshness. Long and structured.</p>			£130

27	Monte Del Fra Ripasso Valpolicella Superiore - Veneto, Italy

	This Ripasso showcases the traditional winemaking technique that infuses the wine with added richness and depth. With its deep ruby colour, it entices the senses with aromas of ripe red berries, dried fruits, and a hint of spice. On the palate, it offers a harmonious balance of fruitiness and structure, with flavours of cherries, plums, and a touch of dark chocolate. The wine's smooth tannins and well-integrated acidity contribute to a lingering and satisfying finish.		
28	Chateau La Fleur Penin St Emilion Grand Cru 2019 - Bordeaux, France
